WHEREAS, the development of the vast resources of the State of Arizona is greatly dependent upon a stable and efficient transportation system; and

WHEREAS, scheduled airline service has deteriorated or has been suspended in many of the smaller Arizona communities; and

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that there will be an additional loss of scheduled airline service; and

WHEREAS, the vast area of our state by geographic standards, and the varied topography, and the sparse population, combine to isolate our communities by long distances, and further make the movement of people and goods difficult; and

WHEREAS, many of our Arizona communities are without rail, bus and air service; and

WHEREAS, the people of the State of Arizona are greatly inconvenienced by an inadequate transportation system between our smaller communities and major hubs; and

WHEREAS, our many military bases located within the State of Arizona serve in the interest of national defense;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors of NAVAJO County joins with other parties within the State of Arizona to give full support to the application of Cochise Airlines for Civil Aeronautics Board certification in order to provide scheduled airline service to communities of Ari-
