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RESOLUTION 21478A

WHEREAS, Arizona Revised Statutes 18-207 precludes public fund expenditures for roads, other than county declared highways, until they have been constructed to county standards; and

WHEREAS, such roads must be fully completed in accordance with a plat approved pursuant to County Planning and Zoning regulations; and

WHEREAS, most property owners are unwilling to pay more taxes in order to avail themselves of any improvement district and such roads, if neglected, deteriorate rapidly; and


WHEREAS, many of these roads, which the county cannot legally maintain, are heavily travelled; and

WHEREAS, the county, although unable to maintain, may bear the burden of legal liability in the event of accidents occurring on such roads;


THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Pinal County Board of Supervisors that the House Bill, reference title: Construction and Maintenance of Public Roads, Amending 18-207 providing that public funds, if available, may be used to construct or maintain county roads, be, and hereby is fully supported for passage in the second Regular Session of the Thirty-Third Legislature.
