## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Association of Counties has served all Counties in Arizona since 1968, as a legal representative, and

WHEREAS, due to increased responsibilities and activities of the Arizona Association of Counties, staff needs are increasing, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Association of Counties, at its Annual Conference held November 2-4, 1977, approved the development of a research and technical assistance division of the Association, and

WHEREAS, the dependence of the Association on Federal Grants creates instability, insecurity and dependency, and

WHEREAS, increased needs of the Association therefore require increased revenues, and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Revised Statutes 11-252 now limits the annual contributions of each Board of Supervisors to \$7,500.00 annually for the Association of Counties, including affiliates and combinations of associations, and


WHEREAS, some Arizona Counties have long contributed the maximum of \$7,500.00 to such organizations.


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Yuma County Board of Supervisors, hereby, in Regular Session, requests the Legislature of the State of Arizona to amend Arizona Revised Statutes 11-252 to remove the limit of \$7,500.00 to be contributed annually and allowing such amounts as are necessary.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this Resolution shall be sent to each County Board of Supervisors, to the Association of Counties, to Senators Sawyer, Osborn and Representatives Bradford and Phillips, and Governor Bolin.
