If the Government shall commence work on the Cottonwood Wash dike as authorized by the Chief of Engineers, Navajo County and the Town of Snowflake shall, in consideration of the Government commencing the work, fulfill the requirements of non-Federal cooperation to wit:

- a. provide without cost to the United States all lands, easements, and right-of-way necessary for the authorized work;
- b. hold and save the United States free from damages due to authorized work;
- c. maintain and operate, in a manner satisfactory to the Chief of Engineers, all of the emergency work after completion.


