

RESOLUTION NO. 51-79

BEFORE THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS,
NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA

WHEREAS, the Scotts Pine Meadows Unit II County Improvement District has been formed to improve the roads contained within its boundaries to County Standards in order that they may be maintained by the County of Navajo, and,

WHEREAS, said subdivision was approved by the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County on the 1st day of June, 1964, and

WHEREAS, at the time of approval said subdivision, the standards pertaining to improvement of roads were different than they are today, including the requirements for the width of right-of-way,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County hereby waive the requirement that Scotts Pine Meadows Unit II County Improvement District bring the roads within said District up to the current County Standards, and instead bring the roads up to the standards existing prior to the adoption of the current County Standards for roads which the County will accept for maintenance.
