

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-80

WHEREAS, substantial planning efforts have been completed for the Cottonwood Wash Watershed Project since the Silver Creek Flood Control District was organized on the 2nd day of May, 1966 by order of the Board of Supervisors, Navajo County, pursuant to Chapter 10 and Chapter 5, Title 45, Arizona Revised Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors became a co-sponsor of the Cottonwood Wash Watershed Project, on the 3rd day of March, 1970 with other watershed sponsors for flood control and water based recreation on Cottonwood Wash, in Navajo County, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors resolved, on the 7th day of August, 1978 that Navajo County shall become the recreational sponsor for said project, and

WHEREAS, Navajo County is interested in seeing the Cottonwood Wash Watershed Project proceed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

1. That, although actual funding would be several years away, Navajo County submit a request to the Arizona Outdoor Recreation Coordinating Commission for consideration as a recipient of State Lake Improvement Funds or other grants for the nonfederal cost allocated to the storage of water for recreation and associated facilities related to said project.

2. This resolution is not a fund obligating document. Financial and other assistance in planning or carrying out the plan is contingent upon the fulfillment of applicable laws and regulations and the availability of appropriations for this purpose.

3. A separate agreement will be entered into between Navajo County and SCS before either party initiates work involving funds of the other party. Such agreements will set forth in detail the financial and working arrangements and other conditions that are applicable to specific works of improvement.
