RESOLUTION No. 80 - 27

WHEREAS in January 1979, the Navajo County Flood Control District did request assistance from the Arizona Water Commission seeking a feasible solution to the flooding problems associated with the Little Colorado River in the vicinity of Winslow, and;

WHEREAS, the Arizona Water Commission did undertake a reconnaissance study of the area, and;

WHEREAS, the Reconnaissance Report presented several alternative plans for the solution to the flooding problems to the Navajo County Flood Control District for their recommendation, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, that on March 12, 1980, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors acting as the Directors of the Navajo County Flood Control District did vote that Plan 1-C should be further studied by the Water Commission, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Navajo County Flood Control District does request that the State Water Commission continue with the plans and specifications for Plan 1-C so that the project may be completed in a timely manner.
