RESOLUTION No. 80 - 35

WHEREAS, on January 23, 1979, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors formed the Navajo County Flood Control District, and;

WHEREAS, the flood control district has received a copy of the Arizona Water Commission Report, "Phase I Inspection Report, National Dam Safety Program", and;

WHEREAS, this report has judged this dam to be unsafe for reservoir storage and recommends further studies be made to determine corrective action, and;

WHEREAS, Lone Pine Dam is an important flood control structure for portions of Navajo County, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, that, based on this report, Navajo County Flood Control District requests the priority order as outlined in a letter to the Arizona Water Commission dated January 31, 1979, be modified to show the Lone Pine Dam study to be the first priority after the Winslow project, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this district does hereby request the assistance of the State Water Commission, as authorized by ARS 45-2301 to 45-2722, to cooperate in this project so that a solution may be found to eliminate the threat to property and life in the area.
