

RESOLUTION AND ORDER 130-81

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA

A RESOLUTION AND ORDER ESTABLISHING AND ORGANIZING DEEP
FOREST DRIVE COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, on the 20th day of October, 1981, the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County set Tuesday November 17, 1981, at the hour of 10:00 A.M., as the time and place for hearing on the Petition for the formation of the Deep Forest Drive County Improvement District and any objections thereto; and

WHEREAS, notice was appropriately posted, published and mailed to the non-resident property owners pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. Sec. 11-705 as amended, laws of the 33rd Legislature, second regular session, 1978, Chapter 59; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Petition is signed by the requisite number of owners of real property, and that the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the District;


NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FOUND, RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Supervisors finds that:
 - a. The Petition is signed by the requisite number of owners of real property;
 - b. That the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the District;
 - c. That notice has been published, posted and mailed pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 11-705;
 - d. That the property included within the District will be benefited thereby;
 - e. That the public health of the inhabitants within the boundaries of the District will be served and promoted by the establishment of the District.

2. That the boundaries of the District shall be those set forth in Exhibit A attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
3. That the Improvement District shall be known in all proceedings as the Deep Forest Drive County Improvement District.
4. That these findings and orders are made after public hearing required by A.R.S. Sec. 11-705.
5. That by virtue of the authority set forth in A.R.S. Sec. 11-706 the Deep Forest Drive County Improvement District is hereby established, formed, organized, and shall be a body corporate with the powers of a municipal corporation for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of Title 11, Chapter 5, Articles 1, 1.1, and 1.2 of the Arizona Revised Statutes.





