APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR A BOATING LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SAFETY FUND GRANT

Navajo County Marine Safety and Patrol Project

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature under ARS 5-383 has authorized the establishment of a Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund providing funds to the Board of Supervisors of Arizona counties for boating law enforcement and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona Outdoor Recreation Coordinating Commission (AORCC) is responsible for the administration of the fund program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by county Boards of Supervisors under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by AORCC require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, where appropriate; and


WHEREAS, the project will contribute to the boating law enforcement and safety programs of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors hereby:


1. Approves the filing of an application for Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund assistance; and







Amount of funds requested: \$55,000


Scope of Project: The purpose of this grant would be to provide personnel and equipment to the Navajo County Sheriffs Department, in order to carry out law enforcement activities and safety programs on all waters and lakes in Navajo County. The personnel would also receive proper training in boating safety and present this information to the public in the form of lectures, educational sessions and one-on-one contact. This project is needed because we do not have an existing program at this time.

Breakdown of Project Expenditures:
