RESOLUTION NO. 31-82

PINETOP-LAKESIDE HEALTH HAZARD

WHEREAS, the Pinetop-Lakeside area has declared health hazard, as determined by the Arizona Department of Health, due to the lack of a complete sewer system, and;

WHEREAS, the economic base potential of the area is being endangered by the restrictions required to lessen the health hazard, and;

WHEREAS, the magnitude of this problem is beyond the capabilities of the local citizens to totally solve on their own, and;

WHEREAS, the Pinetop-Lakeside Sanitary District has pledged \$110,000. of local funds to aid in the solution, now therefore;

BE IT RESOLVED, that Navajo County does hereby certify to the immediate health hazard, and;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Navajo County does hereby request the support and approval of a HUD Grant Application to provide the means to solve this pressing health hazard justified as a necessary action for mitigation of the health hazard, and;

THAT, the County of Navajo will comply with all State CDBG program guidelines, Federal Statutes and regulations applicable to the State CDBG program and the assurances contained in the application.
