A RESOLUTION FIXING TIME AND PLACE OF HEARING AND DIRECTING NOTICE TO THE INHABITANTS OF THE PROPOSED DEEP FOREST-TWO COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County, Arizona, that:

WHEREAS, a Petition for the establishment of a County Improvement District in Navajo County, Arizona, pursuant to Article I, Chapter 5, Title 11, Arizona Revised Statutes, which requests that if established, the District be named the Deep Forest Drive-Two County Road Improvement District, was received by this Board and filed with the Clerk hereof; and

WHEREAS, said Petition is verified by the Petitioners and is accompanied by a plat or sketch indicating the approximate area and boundaries of the proposed District;

NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved, determined and ordered as follows:

1. That Monday, the 19th day of December, 1983, at the hour of 10:30 o'clock a.m. said day being not later than forty (40) days from the date the Petition was filed in the Supervisors chambers, Navajo County Governmental Complex, Holbrook, Arizona, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where this Board will hear said Petition and all matters relating to the establishment of the proposed District, and when and where all interested property owners may appear and be heard, and any person or persons may appear and show cause, if any there may be, why the prayer of the Petitioners' should not be granted, or why any territory should be excluded from said proposed County Improvement District, or other territory included therein, and all written objections to the establishment thereof shall have been filed with the Clerk of this Board before the date set for hearing.
2. The Clerk shall cause a notice, signed by her, announcing the hearing and setting forth the boundaries of the proposed District to be published twice, one week apart, in the Holbrook Tribune News, a newspaper of general circulation published in Navajo County, Arizona, the first of which shall be not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing, and to be posted pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 11-705, not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing; and be mailed by first class mail to the home address of each absentee property owner within the proposed District not less than fourteen (14) days prior to the hearing on the Petition.
