DEEP FOREST DRIVE COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING
THE ENGINEER FOR THE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, within Deep Forest Drive County Improvement District Petitions pursuant to A.R.S. Sections 11-703 and 11-714 have been circulated and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors; signed by the owners of a majority of the frontage of the property fronting on the proposed improvement; and

WHEREAS, in order to adopt a resolution of Intention it is necessary that the Board of Directors designate a District Engineer and have plans and specifications and estimates of the costs and expenses of the improvement prepared by the Engineer and estimates of the assessments must be prepared and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors;


THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Board of Directors of the Deep Forest Drive County Improvement District finds that the Petitions pursuant to A.R.S. Sections 11-703 and 11-714 to authorize expenditures are in good and proper form and substance, and sufficient and conforms in all respects to the requirements of A.R.S. Sections 11-703 and 11-714; and further that the Engineering Firm of:

Standage & Truitt Engineering LTD

hereby authorized pursuant to the attached Contract to proceed with the work necessary prior to the adoption of the Resolution of Intention to order the improvements pursuant to A.R.S. Section 11-711.

STANDARD AGREEMENT FOR
ENGINEERING SERVICES

NAVAJO COUNTY ROAD IMPROVEMENT DISTRICTS

This Agreement made and entered into this 16th day of OCTOBER, 1984,
by and between the Deep Forest Drive Improvement District, hereinafter referred to as
"District and Standage & Truitt Engineering, Ltd., hereinafter referred to as
"Engineer".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, District and Engineer desire to execute and Agreement in regard to such
engineering services as District may desire to obtain for Engineer from time to time;
and

WHEREAS, District contemplates construction of road or other improvements within
Navajo County which will supervise the design procedures and maintain the road
improvements.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the District and Engineer to set forth an understanding
relative to compensation to be paid Engineer for such services, as well as other
related matters;

NOW THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed and understood between the parties as follows:

SECTION I: EMPLOYMENT

The District hereby employs Engineer to furnish the services hereinafter mentioned at
and for the compensation herein stipulated and Engineer hereby accepts such
employment and terms herein stipulated.

SECTION II: SERVICES BY ENGINEER

The services required by Engineer under this Agreement are those described as follows:

A. Plan Revisions:

1. Revise Assessment Diagram
2. Revise Cost Estimate to Current Cost
3. Propose Method of Assessment and Recapitulate Assessments
4. Assist in Soliciting Bid for Construction

B. Contract Administration to Include:

1. Staking of Shoulder Alignment
2. Locate Culverts
3. As-Built Subgrade
4. Bluetop A.B.C. (50' Stations)
5. Inspection of Subgrade, A.B.C., and Paving
6. Approval of Contractors Pay Request

C. Additional Services:

Any change required by action of the County or unforeseen changes shall be made by the engineer as authorized by the County Improvement District on an hourly rate basis as determined by the engineer's standard schedule of compensation attached hereto as Exhibit B. Soils and asphalt tests required during the course of construction shall be made and billed to the District under this item.

SECTION III: EFFECTIVE DATE, TIME PERIOD & TERMINATION OF AGREEMENT

This Agreement shall become effective on the date of the last party to sign. The last party to sign shall insert and initial the effective date on page one of this Agreement, but failure to do so, or correctly to do so, does not change the effective date.

This Agreement shall remain effective until terminated by District or Engineer.

District or Engineer, in the sole discretion of each, may terminate this Agreement by giving ten (10) days prior written notice. In such event, District shall forthwith pay Engineer in full for all work previously authorized and completed. Uncompleted work shall be paid for on a prorated basis determined by District based on the value of the completed work.

SECTION IV: PAYMENT TO ENGINEER

For performance as provided in this Agreement, District, on behalf of the District, shall pay Engineer as follows:

- A. Plan Revisions: For services described in II (A) above, the District shall pay Engineer a lump sum fee of:

\$ 1,300.00


- B. Contract Administration and Inspection: For services described in II (B) above, the District shall pay Engineer a lump sum fee of:

\$ 2,950.00

- C. Additional Engineering Services: For the services described in Section II (C) above, the District shall pay Engineer an actual fee as described in Section II (C) above.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Agreement in duplicate of the date set opposite their names.


