RESOLUTION NO. 25-85

A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
REQUESTING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE FROM
THE GOVERNOR AND THE ARIZONA STATE LEGISLATURE

WHEREAS, Navajo County has been fiscally conservative;
and

WHEREAS, The Federal Government is threatening to
eliminate Federal Revenue Sharing and reduce National Forest Fees
by 86% which will reduce our revenues by \$1,140,000; and

WHEREAS, The Federal Governments proposed budget cuts
will effect other County revenues such as; Emergency Services
reimbursements and Health Grants, and

WHEREAS, in budget year 1983/84 the Legislature allowed
Counties a formula share of the temporary one cent sales tax with
Navajo County receiving \$1,452,000 and then in 1984/85 giving each
County \$400,000, and;

WHEREAS, no Legislative provision has been made for
revenue relief for Fiscal Year 1985/86, and;

WHEREAS, the Legislature has imposed changes in the
AHCCCS program which has shifted costs from the State to the
Counties, specifically, the one day retro for emergency cases and
the corresponding eligibility rule changes; and


WHEREAS, these AHCCCS changes are expected to cost
Navajo County in excess of \$1 million, and;

WHEREAS, Navajo County does not have the levy ability,
through no fault of our own, to make up for the above delineated
revenue shortfalls, and;

WHEREAS, The Governor has announced a multi-million
dollar State revenue surplus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County are requesting financial assistance from the Governor and the Arizona State Legislature.

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
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
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
