RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE BUDGET

FISCAL YEAR 1985/86

---

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provision of Title 42, Section 301, 302, 303 and 304, A.R.S., the Board of Supervisors did, on the 13th day of August, 1985, make an estimate of the different amounts required to meet the public expenditures for the ensuing year, also an estimate of revenues from sources other than direct taxation, and the amount to be raised by taxation upon real and personal property of Navajo County, and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said sections of said title, and following due public notice, the Board met on the 13th day of August, 1985 at which meeting any taxpayer was privileged to appear and be heard in favor of or against any of the proposed expenditures or tax levies, and

WHEREAS, it appears that publication has been duly made as required by law, of said estimates together with a notice that the Board would meet on the 13th day of August, 1985, at the office of the Board for the purpose of making tax levies as set forth in said estimates, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the sums to be raised by taxation, as specified therein, do not in the aggregate amount exceed that amount as computed in Title 42, Section 301.A, A.R.S.,


