**A RESOLUTION FIXING AMOUNT AND APPROVING BOND, FIXING TIME
AND PLACE OF HEARING ON THE QUESTION OF FORMATION OF THE
NAVAJO SKIES COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, a Petition for the establishment of the Navajo Skies County Improvement District in Navajo County, Arizona, pursuant to Article 1, Chapter 5, Title 11, Arizona Revised Statutes, which requests that if established, the District be named the Navajo Skies County Improvement District, was received by this Board and filed with the Clerk hereof; and

WHEREAS, said Petition is certified by the Petitioners and is accompanied by a plat or sketch indicating the approximate area and boundaries of the proposed District; and

WHEREAS, accompanying said Petition is a Bond in the amount of FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00), conditioned upon the payment to the County of all expenses incurred by this Board in the proceedings, in case this Board refuses to establish the District;


NOW, THEREFORE, it is resolved, determined and ordered as follows:

1. The Bond is approved as good and sufficient pursuant to the terms and conditions of A.R.S Sec. 11-704.
2. That Tuesday the 6th day of August, 1985, at the hour of 10:15 o'clock A.M. said day being not later than forty (40) days from the date the Petition was filed in the Supervisors chambers, Navajo County, Holbrook, Arizona, is hereby fixed as the time and place when and where this Board will hear said Petition and all matters relating to the establishment of the proposed District, and when and where all interested property owners may appear and be heard, and any person or persons may appear and show cause, if any there may be, why the prayer of the Petitioners should not be granted, or why any territory should be excluded from said proposed District, or other territory included therein, and all written objections to the establishment thereof shall have been filed with the Clerk of this Board before the date set for hearing.

3. The Clerk shall cause a signed notice, announcing the hearing and setting forth the boundaries of the proposed District to be published twice, one week apart, in the White Mountain Independent, a newspaper of general circulation published in Navajo County, Arizona, the first of which shall be not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing, and to be posted pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 11-705, not less than ten (10) days prior to the date of the hearing and to be mailed, by first-class mail to the home address of each property owner within the proposed District.

DESCRIPTION WITH TWO COMMERCIAL LOTS
WITHIN SECTION 33, T12N, R17E

Beginning at the SW corner of Section 33, T12N, R17E the True Point of Beginning; Thence N $0^{\circ}13'48''$ W, 431.59 feet to a point on the easterly right-of-way line of United States Forest Service (USFS) Road #51; Thence along the right-of-way line of USFS Road #51 along a curve which has a cord length of 144.03 feet and a cord bearing of N $14^{\circ}33'49''$ E; Thence S $79^{\circ}19'43''$ E; Thence S $79^{\circ}19'43''$ E, 539.73 feet; Thence N $7^{\circ}33'55''$ E, 500.00 feet to a point on the northerly right-of-way line of Highway 260; Thence along said right-of-way line easterly through a curve concave southerly which has a central angle of $15^{\circ}36'31''$, length of 1275.65 feet and a radius of 4682.62 feet; thence S $0^{\circ}29'16''$ W, 971.63 feet to a point on the south line of Section 33; Thence along said Section line S $89^{\circ}55'37''$ W, 1869.50 feet to the SW corner of said Section 33, the True Point of Beginning.
