

RESOLUTION NO. 22-86

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA

A RESOLUTION GRANTING PERMISSION TO PROCEED TO ESTABLISH A DOMESTIC WATER IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, Chapter 338, Session Laws 36th Legislature, Second Regular Session, was signed by the Governor of the State of Arizona and filed in the Office of the Secretary of State on May 2, 1984 said act to be effective on August 3, 1984; and

WHEREAS, said Act prohibits the formation or initiation or circulation of petitions to form domestic water improvement districts authorized by Title 48, Chapter 6, Articles 1 and 4, Arizona Revised Statutes until December 31, 1986, except as provided in Section 2 of subsection C; and

WHEREAS, Section 2 of subsection C of said Act provides for permission to begin proceedings to create a domestic water improvement district before December 31, 1986; and

WHEREAS, permission shall be applied for in writing to begin proceedings to create a domestic water improvement district before December 31, 1986; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors may authorize by resolution proceedings to establish a domestic water improvement district; and

WHEREAS, a concerted effort will be made to establish the most cost-effective facility for the provision of domestic water; and

WHEREAS, the formation of the Overgaard Domestic Water Improvement District shall facilitate compliance with the Arizona Department of Health Services water quality requirements and shall facilitate fire protection; and

WHEREAS, the public health, comfort, convenience, necessity and welfare will be promoted by establishment of the district and the property included therein will be benefitted.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS THAT:


1. The application for permission to proceed with the formation of the Overgaard Domestic Water Improvement District is hereby accepted by the Board of Supervisors.
2. Permission is hereby granted to begin and continue proceedings to create the Overgaard Domestic Water Improvement District authorized by Title 48, Chapter 6, Articles 1 and 4, Arizona Revised Statutes before December 31, 1986.
3. The Board of Supervisors, by a separate resolution, will approve establishment of the Overgaard Domestic Water Improvement District if the formation proceedings, held pursuant to Title 48, Chapter 6, Articles 1 and 4, Arizona Revised Statutes, are successful.

Commencing at the Southwest Corner of Section 29, Township 12N R17E, G.& S.R. B & M, thence Easterly along said line to the Eastern line of Arizona State Highway 260, thence Northwesterly along the Eastern line of Arizona State Highway 260 to the South point of Assessors Parcel 206-15-7B, thence Northeasterly along the Southern boundary of Assessors Parcel 206-15-7B, to the Eastern most point of said parcel; thence East along the South line of Assessors Parcel 206-15-7A; thence Northwesterly along the Eastern side of Assessors Parcel 206-15-7A and 206-15-17A to the Northern point of said Assessors Parcel 206-15-17A; thence Southwesterly to the Western point of said Assessors Parcel 206-15-17A; thence Northwesterly along the Eastern line of Assessors Parcel 206-15-16D to the Northern point of said parcel; thence Southwesterly along the Northern boundary of said parcel to the point where it intersects the Easterly line of Arizona State Highway 260; thence Northwesterly along the Easterly line of said highway to the point where it intersects the line between Corners seven (7) and eight (8) of H.E.S. 460; thence Southwesterly along the aforesaid line between Corner seven (7) and eight (8) of H.E.S. 460 to Corner seven (7) of H.E.S. 460; thence Southeasterly along the line between Corners six (6) and seven (7) of H.E.S. 460, a distance approximately 950 feet to the Northeast Corner of Assessors Parcel 206-15-2A, thence Westerly along the North line of Assessors Parcel 206-15-2A to the Western line of Section 29, T.12N. R.17E; thence Southerly along the aforesaid Western line of Section 29, T.12N. R.17E to the Point of Beginning. All references to Assessors Parcels are as found in the records of the Navajo County Assessor, February 12, 1986.
