RESOLUTION NO. 25-86

A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
RELATING TO GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT

SECTION 1. The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does hereby acknowledge that a petition was duly filed by Daryl Brimhall, requesting a Special Use Permit to operate an asphalt batch plant and to store paving equipment & mater. located on the following described property Adamana Interchange on I-40, a portion of T19N-R23E, G&SRB&M, Section 34, SW, Lot 297 APN 106-84-14 for the purpose of the operation of a batch plant and storage area for paving equipment and materials.

SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors after a duly noticed Public Hearing having been held, has reviewed the aforementioned request for a Special Use Permit and having also considered the recommendation by the Planning Commission, has determined that the requested Special Use Permit be granted according to the following conditions:

1. Proper cleanup of the site once operation is terminated
2. Compliance with all appreciable laws and regulations for dust control, noise and creating a nuisance
3. Hours of operation that do not disturb the residents
4. Length of permit set for 5 years


SECTION 3. This permit hereby allowed is conditional upon the privileges being utilized within six (6) months after the effective date thereof, and if they are not utilized or construction work begun within said time and carried on diligently in accordance with conditions imposed by the Board, the authorization shall become void, and any privilege or permit granted shall be deemed to have elapsed.

SECTION 4. This action shall become final and effective thirty (30) days after adoption of this resolution unless during that time a written appeal is submitted by any person to the Board of Supervisors.
