**A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
RELATING TO DENYING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT**


SECTION 1. The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does hereby acknowledge that a petition was duly filed by D & M Communication, requesting a Special Use Permit to: construct for operation 5 radio towers and a transmitter building in the A-General Zone located on the following described property a portion of the NW 1/4, NW 1/4 of Section 3, T9N-R22E, G&SRB&M, A.K.A. APN 212-02-003 for the purpose of radio transmission.

SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors after a duly noticed Public Hearing having been held, has reviewed the aforementioned request for a Special Use Permit and having also considered the recommendation by the Planning Commission, has determined that the requested Special Use Permit be denied for the following reasons:


SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors does hereby disapprove the said requested Special Use Permit and declines to grant same.
