

RESOLUTION NO. 45-86

**NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RESULTS OF THE
PINETOP-LAKESIDE SANITARY DISTRICT ANNEXATION ELECTION**

WHEREAS, on the 3rd of June 1986, an election concerning the annexation of property into the Pinetop-Lakeside Sanitary District was held; and

WHEREAS, the votes have been tallied by the election board; and

WHEREAS, it is the duty of the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County to canvass the returns; and

WHEREAS, after the Board of Supervisors canvasses its returns, it is its duty to issue a Certificate of Result; and

WHEREAS, a certified permanent copy of the official canvass for ballot measures shall be mailed immediately to the Secretary of State who shall maintain and preserve it as a public record, as well as being recorded with the Navajo County Recorder.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

The Board of Supervisors of Navajo County hereby canvasses the results of the Pinetop-Lakeside Sanitary District Annexation Election pursuant to Arizona Revised Statutes Sections 16-646 and 48-2003 and the general election laws of the State of Arizona, and further, certifies the results as follows:

**CERTIFICATE OF RESULT OF ANNEXATION ELECTION
HELD FOR THE PINETOP-LAKESIDE SANITARY DISTRICT OF
NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA ON JUNE 3, 1986**

It is hereby certified by the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County, Arizona, as follows:

1. That an annexation election was duly called and held for the Annexation of Territory to the Pinetop-Lakeside Sanitary District, Navajo County, Arizona, hereinafter referred to as the District, on June 3, 1986, under the provisions of Title 48, Chapter 14, Article 1, Arizona Revised Statutes, when there was submitted to the qualified electors of the District, the question as shown on the attached form of ballot;
2. That the poll and tally list and certified returns of the election

boards that conducted the bond election were filed and that on June 10, 1986, which is within ten days following the date of election, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors met at the regular place of meeting and canvassed the returns of the annexation election as prescribed by law;

3. That the undersigned Board of Supervisors further certifies that the object of the annexation election was to obtain authority from the qualified electors of the Territory to be annexed to the District to annex the Territory described in the attached ballot;


4. That the undersigned do further find and certify, after careful and complete canvass of the election returns, that in answer to the question submitted to the qualified electors of the Territory to be annexed to the District at the annexation election, the majority of the votes cast were cast in favor of the Annexation of Territory described in the question submitted at the election and that the election had been conducted and the returns thereof made as required by law and that the results of the election is set forth in the following tabulation of election returns, to wit:

That it is therefore ordered by this Board of Directors that the Territory referenced in the ballot and described in the resolution calling the election be annexed to the Pinetop-Lakeside Sanitary District, upon the Dissolution of the Pinetop Lakes Sanitary District, said annexation to be effective for the tax year commencing after December 31, 1986.


NOTICE TO VOTERS:
