

RESOLUTION 78-86

WHEREAS, CLAYSPRINGS WATER SERVICE, aprivately owned service, has presented tot the Board an application for renewal of their Franchise and the authority, together with all right-of-ways necessary, toextend, construct, main-
tain and operate its domestic water system for the purpose of furnishing water to the trsidents and business establishments within the Gounty of Navajo, State of Arizona, in that certian area more specifically described as follows.

ALL of Sections 10 - 11 - 14 - and 15 in the Township 11 North

Range 19 East G & S R B & M, Navajo County, Arizona

and having therewith presented the proposed Franchise to be renewed together with Notice of intention to renew said Franchise for publication; and

WHEREAS, this Board is of the opinion that said domestic water system is necessary to provide water to residence and business establishments in the above-described area within the County of Navajo, Arizona, and that said application should be granted; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED that said Franchise will be renewed in accordance with the application of the ClaySprings Water Service at 10:30 o'clock A.M. on the 14th day of October, 1986, unless before said date more than fifty (50 %) of the qualified electors residing in the above decribed area of Na vajo County, Arizona, petition the Board of supervisors to deny such privilege; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board cause to be published a copy of this Notice of Intention to renew such Franchise once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks prior to said hearing in the White Mtn. Independen, a news paper of general circulation, published within the County of Navajo, Arizona.
