WHEREAS, the Arizona State Legislature under A.R.S. §5-383 has authorized the establishment of a Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund (BLESF) providing funds to the Board of Supervisors of Arizona counties for boating law enforcement and safety; and

WHEREAS, the Arizona State Parks Board is responsible for the administration of the fund program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by county Boards of Supervisors under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by State Parks require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the project will contribute to the boating law enforcement and safety programs of the County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund assistance; and
2. Certifies that Navajo County will comply with all appropriate state regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application; and
3. Understands that the project scope and funding amount are subject to final approval by the State Parks Board and the State Legislature; and
4. Authorizes the Sheriff, Glen L. Flake, to act on behalf of Navajo County in conducting all negotiations, executing and submitting all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the BLESF project.





Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund  
Application Procedures

Program Summary

Under the provisions of the Arizona Revised Statutes, Title 5, Section 383, the Arizona State Legislature established the Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund (BLESF) program. The purpose of this program is to provide grants to Arizona counties through the Boards of Supervisors to support county boating law enforcement and safety activities. BLESF grants are to be used by county law enforcement agencies solely for boating law enforcement personnel, training and equipment.

The Arizona State Parks Board is now responsible for the administration of the BLESF program. BLESF grants may be distributed to applying counties for projects which do not exceed twenty-five percent of the total funds available during the fiscal year in which the funds are collected. Counties that had boating law enforcement and safety programs in existence before July 1, 1980 are required to match BLESF grants by at least an equal amount from their boating law enforcement and safety program budget.

Application Procedures

Counties interested in applying for FY1985-86 BLESF grant assistance are required to submit two completed copies of the enclosed application form and provide a resolution adopted by the County Board of Supervisors authorizing the submittal of the BLESF application. Instructions for completing the application form are found on the reverse side of the form. The resolution must also specify, by name, the County official authorized by the Board to act on behalf of the County in conducting all business pertaining to the grant. A sample resolution (Exhibit A) is also enclosed and may be used as a guide.

To be eligible for FY1985-86 BLESF grant consideration, counties must submit two copies of the completed application form and an adopted resolution to:


