RESOLUTION OF THE  
NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

WHEREAS the Navajo County School Superintendent has recommended to the NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that the Board enter into an intergovernmental agreement with various school districts from Navajo and Apache County to create a Two County District Superintendent's Association and to appoint the Navajo County School Superintendent as the fiscal agent for said association, and


WHEREAS the legal status of the Two County District Superintendents Association will be created by this agreement, and

WHEREAS there are funds that are presently in the control of said association as it has previously existed that need to be controlled and expended as originally intended by the school districts, and

WHEREAS the Navajo County School Superintendent has the authority pursuant to A.R.S. §15-365 to enter into this agreement for the expenditure of said funds for special programs to improve the education of the students in this district.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is authorized to sign the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement to create the Two County District Superintendent's Association, to appoint the Navajo County School Superintendent as the fiscal agent of the association and for such other and further matters that may be related thereto.
