

RESOLUTION NO 29-87

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
NAVAJO COUNTY ADOPTING AN AMENDMENT TO
THE NAVAJO COUNTY SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS

The Board of Supervisors of Navajo County does resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine the following recommended amendment was duly given and published, that a public hearing was duly held on the 6 day of April, 19 87, and that the public necessity, convenience and general welfare and good zoning practice require that the following amendment and change be made.

SECTION 2. The Planning and Zoning Commission hereby adopts the change and amendment of the text of ~~SECTION~~ Article XI (adding) entitled Fences and Cattleguards of the Navajo County Subdivision Regulations to read as follows:

ARTICLE XI

FENCES AND CATTLEGUARDS

SECTION 11.1

All subdivisions subject to this ordinance, as required by the Director, shall be fenced.

SECTION 11.2

All subdivisions paralleling a County highway shall be fenced along the cleared right-of-way line with a standard right-of-way fence to fit area of development as required by the Director.

SECTION 11.3

Steel and concrete cattleguards shall be placed on all fence lines at all access roads entering the subdivisions from an opened or free area, as in Section 11.1 above.

SECTION 11.4

The developer and all initial and subsequent purchasers shall be responsible to ensure compliance with this Article on land that was subject to this ordinance.
