WHEREAS, the Navajo County Personnel Commission and Personnel Department have submitted for consideration amendments and revisions to the existing Personnel Policy; and


WHEREAS, the elected officials and appointed department heads of Navajo County have reviewed the document and have submitted for consideration amendments and revisions to the existing Personnel Policy

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors reserves unto itself the power to amend or make exception to these rules, regulations, policies and resolutions.


