WHEREAS, Petersen Water Company, an Arizona proprietorship, has presented to the board an application for franchise and the authority, together with all rights-of-way necessary, to extend, construct, maintain and operate its domestic water system for the purpose of furnishing water to residents and business establishments within the County of Navajo State of Arizona, in that certain area more specifically described as follows, to-wit:

All of sections 20,21,28 and 29 all in township 13 north range 20 east, G & S R.B & M., Navajo County, Arizona, excepting gas, oil and minerals which are reserved.


and having therewith presented the proposed Franchise to be granted, together with notice of Intention to grant said franchise for publication; and

WHEREAS, this board is of the opinion that said domestic water system is necessary to provide water to residents and business establishments in the above-described area within the County of Navajo, Arizona, and now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED the hearing will be held for the application of Petersen Water Company at 9:30 o'clock a.m., on the 14th day of March 1988 unless before said date more than fifty (50%) of the qualified electors of Navajo County, Arizona, shall petition the Board of Supervisors to deny such privilege; and the board will receive testimony for or against granting said franchise at the hearing.

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Board cause to be published a copy of notice of Intention to grant such Franchise once a week for three consecutive weeks prior to said hearing in the Holbrook Tribune, a newspaper of general circulation, published within the County of Navajo, AZ.
