A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY  
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS GRANTING/ A  
CHANGE OF ZONE CLASSIFICATION EXTENSION

The Board of Supervisors of Navajo County does resolve as follows:


The Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine that a zone change request was granted to First United State Credit Union, Mesa, Arizona \*at a public hearing on the 17th day of June, 19 86, to permit 23 lots on 127 acres on the following property:

A PORTION OF H.E.S. 196 IN SECTION 1, T11N-R15E AND SECTION 36, T12N-R15E, A PORTION OF APN 207-26-01A, 2C, 3 AND 2B

The Board of Supervisors does hereby GRANT/ an extension for the period of 24 months for the amendment to the Navajo County Zoning Maps referred to herein, so as to change from the A-General zone to the Special Development zone.

The Zone Change allowed is conditional upon privileges being utilized within two (2) years after the effective date thereof. Therefore, this authorization shall become void, and any privilege, permit or variance granted shall be deemed to have elapsed. The zoning classification on said property shall revert to A-General.
