**A RESOLUTION AND ORDER ESTABLISHING AND ORGANIZING  
HIDDEN WAY ROAD ACCESS COUNTY IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT**

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County set May 23, 1988, at the hour of 10:30 o'clock a.m., as the time and place for the hearing on the formation of the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District and any objections thereto; and

WHEREAS, notice was appropriately posted, published and mailed to the property owners pursuant to the provisions of A.R.S. Sec. 48-905; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the Petition is signed by the requisite number of owners of real property and the requisite number of qualified electors, and that the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FOUND, RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Supervisors finds that:
  - a. The Petition is signed by a majority of the persons owning real property or by the owners of more than fifty-one percent (51%) of the real property and more than fifty percent (50%) of the qualified electors, which is the requisite number of owners as provided by A.R.S. Sec. 48-903;
  - b. That the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District;
  - c. That notice has been published, posted and mailed pursuant to A.R.S. Sec. 48-905;
  - d. That the property included within the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District will be benefited thereby.
2. That the boundaries of the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District shall be those set forth in Exhibits A and B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.
3. That the Improvement District shall be known in all proceedings as the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District.
4. That these findings and orders are made after public hearing

required by A.R.S. Sec. 48-905.

5. That by virtue of the authority set forth in A.R.S. Sec. 48-906 the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District is hereby established, formed, organized, and shall be a body corporate with the powers of a municipal corporation for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of Title 48, Chapter 6, Articles 1, 2 and 3 of the Arizona Revised Statutes.
6. That request is hereby made of the Department of Property Valuation, State of Arizona, that the establishment of the Hidden Way Road Access County Improvement District become effective for assessment and tax levying purposes for the tax years beginning from and after December 31, 1988.
7. That the Clerk of the Board file with said Department and with the County Assessor of Navajo County, a certified copy of this resolution on or before November 1, 1988.
8. That said filing shall constitute the notice provided to be given pursuant to A.R.S. Section 42-483.


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EXHIBIT A

The Hidden Way Road Access Improvement District is the Navajo County road as it leaves Fawnbrook Rd. of the Fawnbrook Subdivision. The road and spur extend one-half mile providing access to all persons (27) listed in Navajo County maps, 212-04 and one member of 210-33. The taxation would be divided equally by all members of the outlines district. The spur (can be named) gives access from Hidden Way to five area residents. Members on aread 212-04-192 B, 195 B, 178, and 156 E, will dedicate necessary land for improvement. The attached map describes all the residents in the county assessor's attached map.
