**A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
TERMINATING
A SPECIAL USE PERMIT**

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does resolve as follows:


SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors, at a duly noticed Public Hearing held on the 21st day of September, 1987, adopted Resolution No. 80A-87 granting a Special Use Permit for:

The construction and operation of a retail sales and dry storage building in conjunction with an existing sawmill operation on APN 212-38-019A.

SECTION 2. The Board of Supervisors finds that the owner of the property described therein has not complied with conditions of Resolution No. 80A-87.


SECTION 3. THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors does hereby **REVOKE AND TERMINATE** Resolution No. 80A-87 and requires the owner of the property described therein to cease and desist all use of land related to the business and operations permitted under the Special Use Permit and return the use of the land to compliance with the regulations of the underlying zoning district.
