

RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

NUMBER 16-89

WHEREAS the Navajo County School Superintendent has recommended to the Navajo County Board of Supervisors that the Board enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement with various school districts from Navajo and Apache Counties heretofore known as the Two County District Superintendents' Association and hereby adopts the name of Navapache Administrators' Association and to appoint the Navajo County School Superintendent as the fiscal agent for said Association, and,


WHEREAS the legal status of the Navapache Administrators' Association has been created by this agreement, and,

WHEREAS there are funds that are presently in the control of said association as it has previously existed that need to be controlled and expended as originally intended, and,

WHEREAS the school boards and the Supervisors have the authority pursuant to ARS 15-365 to enter into this agreement for the expenditure of said funds for special programs to improve the education of the students in these districts:

BE IT RESOLVED that the Navajo County School Superintendent is authorized to participate in the Intergovernmental Agreement with the Navapache Administrators' Association and appoint the Navajo County School Superintendent as the fiscal agent of the Association and for such other matters that may be related thereto.
