A RESOLUTION AND ORDER ESTABLISHING AND ORGANIZING
MC LAWS ROAD FIRE DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of Navajo County set September 11, 1989, at the hour of 9:45 a.m., as the time and place for the hearing on the formation of the McLaws Road Fire District and any objections thereto; and

WHEREAS, a petition for formation was submitted by proponents of the district on August 28, 1989, and

WHEREAS, it appears that the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the McLaws Road Fire District as determined by the Board of Supervisors at the public hearing on July 17, 1989.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS FOUND, RESOLVED, DETERMINED AND ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Board of Supervisors finds that:
 - a. The Petition is signed by more than one-half of the property owners in the area of the proposed district;
 - b. The Petition is signed by persons owning collectively, more than one-half of the assessed valuation of the property in the area of the proposed district;
 - c. The Petition is signed by more than one-half of the qualified electors within the boundaries of the proposed district;
 - d. That the public convenience, necessity or welfare will be promoted by the establishment of the McLaws Road Fire District;
 - e. That the property included within the McLaws Road Fire District will be benefited thereby.

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2. That the boundaries of the McLaws Road Fire District shall be those set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

3. That the Fire District shall be known in all proceedings as the McLaws Road Fire District.

4. That the organizing members of the Board of Directors shall be as follows:



6. That by virtue of the authority set forth in A.R.S. Section 48-261 the McLaws Road Fire District is hereby established, formed, organized, and shall be a body corporate with the powers of a municipal corporation for the purposes of carrying out the provisions of Title 48, Chapter 5 of the Arizona Revised Statutes. Establishment of this District becomes effective 30 days from the date this resolution is adopted.
