RESOLUTION NO. 13-90

A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
GRANTING/DENYING
THE ABANDONMENT OF A COUNTY INTEREST

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does resolve as follows:

SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine that the following request for abandonment of this County Interest was initiated and filed by HENRY SHAW, and a Public Hearing was duly held on the 22nd day of January, 1990, to abandon:

AN EASEMENT DESCRIBED AS THE ONE (1) ROD ROAD ON THE SOUTHERN-MOST END OF LOT #28, HOLLADAY ACRES, AS RECORDED IN NAVAJO COUNTY RECORDER'S BOOK 2 OF PLATS, PAGE 18; THE LAKESIDE AREA.

SECTION 2. The aforementioned petitioner has filed a request in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Navajo County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations.

SECTION 3. The Board of Supervisors, pursuant to ARS §18-210 and ARS §28-1902 has found that the subject roadway, street, alley or easement **is/is not** necessary for public use as a throughway.

SECTION 4. The Board of Supervisors does hereby GRANT/DENY the abandonment of the County Interest on the following described property:

AS DESCRIBED ABOVE

SECTION 5. Upon the abandonment of said County Interest the property described be vested in title and accrued to the owners of the land abutting such vacated portions pursuant to ARS §28-1902.
