

RESOLUTION NO. 30-91

A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
GRANTING/DENYING  
A SPECIAL USE PERMIT EXTENSION

The Board of Supervisors of Navajo County does resolve as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine that a Special Use Permit was adopted by the Board on the 18TH day of DECEMBER, 19 89, Resolution No. 127-89, as initiated by RICHARD HUGHES OF MOUNTAIN RECYCLING to permit the following:

**THE OPERATION OF A RECYCLING CENTER**

on the following described property:

**IN THE N $\frac{1}{2}$ , S $\frac{1}{2}$ , NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , SECTION 35, T9N-R22E, G&SRM, NAVAJO COUNTY, ARIZONA. A.K.A. A PORTION OF THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$  OF APN 212-38-019A, MEASURING 180 FEET DEEP BY 80 FEET FRONTAGE; THE LAKESIDE AREA.**

**SECTION 2.** The Board of Supervisors further acknowledge that a petition was duly filed by (Planning Commission initiated action) requesting an extension of the aforementioned Special Use Permit.


**SECTION 3.** The Board of Supervisors, after a duly noticed Public Hearing having been held on the 3rd day of JUNE, 19 91, has reviewed the aforementioned request for a Special Use Permit Extension and having also considered the recommendation by the Planning Commission, has determined that the requested Special Use Permit Extension has been GRANTED/DENIED for the following reasons:

**SECTION 4.** If granted by the Board of Supervisors this permit is conditional upon the privileges being utilized within August 1, 1991 months after the effective date thereof, and if they are not utilized or construction work begun within said time and carried on diligently in accordance with conditions imposed by the Board, the authorization may be made void and any privilege or permit granted deemed to have elapsed upon a duly noticed hearing of the Board of Supervisors. This action shall become final and effective thirty (30) days after adoption of this Resolution unless during that time a written appeal is submitted by any person to the Board of Supervisors.

**SECTION 5.** If denied by the Board of Supervisors, this action shall become final and effective thirty (30) days after the date of adoption of this Resolution unless during that time an appeal specifying new evidence bearing upon this matter is submitted in writing to the Board of Supervisors.
