SECTION 1. The Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine that a petition was duly filed by Terry Boyd agent for Neal Hart, on the following described property:

Approximately 1 mile northwest of Show Low Town limits in a Portion of Section 10, T10N-R21E. APN 209-26-019.

to permit the following:

Placement of a radio station antenna system



The Board of Supervisors, after a duly noticed Public Hearing having been held on the 8th day of February, 1993, has reviewed the aforementioned request for a Special Use Permit and having also considered the recommendation by the Planning Commission, has determined that the requested Special Use Permit be GRANTED/~~DENIED~~ for the following reasons:


SECTION 3. Further if GRANTED, the Board of Supervisors imposes the following stipulations in accordance with the attached site plan:

1. All required permits from the FAA and FCC are obtained.
2. If there is any interference from the tower it is the responsibility of Mr. Boyd to rectify the problems.

SECTION 4. The Secretary shall certify the adoption of this Resolution and shall transmit certified copies to the applicant and the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors.
