RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE CREATION OF A WHITE MOUNTAIN DISTRICT AND HOLBROOK DISTRICT OF THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation is proposing to reorganize their district office, to facilitate better service to the citizens of our State by instituting quality management principles, and in compliance with Governor Symington's Project S.L.I.M.; and

WHEREAS, because of the unique needs in Navajo County caused by severe weather extremes and heavy winter snows, we feel two districts should be created in order to assign experienced personnel, especially engineering staff, familiar with the construction and maintenance techniques, snow removal, and ice and snow removal/mitigation required in the type of environment found within Navajo County; and

WHEREAS, Navajo County Board of Supervisors supports the White Mountain Regional Transportation Committee's (WMRTC) concern that serving the White Mountain area from a Globe district office would not be in the best interests of the citizens of the White Mountain Region and Navajo County; and

WHEREAS, a district located in Holbrook, that would specifically serve Navajo and Apache Counties from Interstate-40 north ward, staffed with personnel familiar with construction and maintenance techniques, would best serve the region.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors propose that a White Mountain District and Holbrook District be created to more efficiently deal with the unique problems of these regions (see attached map); and










ADOT's Proposed Re-districting Map


