**A RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

THE ABANDONMENT OF A COUNTY INTEREST**

The Navajo County Board of Supervisors does resolve as follows:

**SECTION 1.** The Board of Supervisors does hereby declare and determine that the following request for abandonment of this County Interest was by KNUTE CRAWFORD, and a Public Hearing was duly held on the 18TH, day of JANUARY, 1994, to abandon:

**A PORTION OF ZANE GREY ROAD.**

**SECTION 2.** The aforementioned petitioner has filed a request in accordance with rules and regulations of the Navajo County Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Regulations.

**SECTION 3.** The Board of Supervisors, pursuant to ARS §18-210 and ARS §28-1902 has found the subject roadway, street, alley or easement IS/[REDACTED] necessary for public use as a throughway.

**SECTION 4.** The Board of Supervisors does hereby [REDACTED]/DENY the abandonment of the County Interest on the following described property.

**LOCATED BETWEEN LOTS 31 & 32 PINETOP LAKES COUNTRY CLUB MOBILE HOMES UNIT 2.  
APN'S 211-55-31 & 32.**

**SECTION 5.** Upon the abandonment of said County Interest the property described be vested in title and accrued to the owners of the land abutting such vacated portion pursuant to ARS §28-1902.
