**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRMAN TO SIGN THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL
AGREEMENT JPA 95-20 WITH
THE ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR
INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF
HIGHWAYS US 60, SR 77 AND PENROD ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Transportation has found it necessary and desirable that certain improvements be made on the State Highway System within Navajo County; and


WHEREAS, said improvements include installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Highways US 60, SR 77 and Penrod Road; and

WHEREAS, subject improvements have been justified by a signal warrant study; and

WHEREAS, Navajo County also desires improved road safety when its road system adjoins with the State Highway System; now

THEREFORE, LET IT BE RESOLVED that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors is empowered by ARS §11-251 to enter into this agreement with the State of Arizona supporting the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of Highways US 60, SR 77 and Penrod Road and authorizes the Chairman to sign said agreement.
