RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

APPROVING THE APPLICATION TO THE ARIZONA STATE PARKS BOARD FOR A BOATING LAW ENFORCEMENT AND SAFETY FUND GRANT

WHEREAS, The Arizona State Legislature under A.R.S. § 5-383 has authorized the establishment of a Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund (BLESF) providing funds to the Board of Supervisors of Arizona counties for boating law enforcement and safety; and

WHEREAS, The Arizona State Parks Board is responsible for the administration of the fund program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by county Boards of Supervisors under the program; and

WHEREAS, said procedures established by State Parks require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, where appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the project will contribute to the boating law enforcement and safety programs of the County;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund assistance; and
2. Certified that Navajo County will comply with all appropriate state regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application; and
3. Understands that the project scope and funding amount are subject to approval by the Arizona Outdoor Recreation Coordinating Commission and the State Parks Board; and

4. Authorizes the Sheriff to act on behalf of Navajo County in conducting all negotiations, executing and submitting all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the BLESF project.







* GOAL:

THE NAVAJO COUNTY SHERIFF DEPARTMENT WILL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE BOATERS OF NAVAJO COUNTY, WITH THE NECESSARY PATROL AND EDUCATION NEEDED FOR THE THEIR SAFETY, THE SAFE OPERATION OF THEIR BOATS AND THEIR PROTECTION ON THE WATERWAYS WITHIN NAVAJO COUNTY.

* OBJECTIVE:

WITH THE HELP OF ARIZONA STATE PARKS, THE SHERIFF DEPARTMENT WILL GAIN ONE FULL TIME BOATING OFFICER. WITH THIS PERSON, HIGHER VISIBILITY THROUGH ESTABLISHED PATROL CAN BE ACHIEVED.

WE WILL CONTINUE GIVING THE BOATERS AND THE PUBLIC, PROGRAMS ON BOATING AND WATER SAFETY, THIS WILL BE DONE DURING THE PEAK AND OFF SEASON. WE WILL ATTEND PUBLIC SCHOOLS, AND SAFETY FAIRS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY, GIVING PEOPLE AN IDEA OF WHAT IS AVAILABLE FROM OUR DEPARTMENT.

* PROGRAM NARRATIVE:

THE NAVAJO COUNTY LAKE PATROL PROGRAM, CURRENTLY HAS TWO PATROL BOATS. ONE BOAT LOCATED IN THE NORTH HALF OF THE COUNTY AND ONE IN THE SOUTH. A THIRD BOAT WAS DONATED TO THE COUNTY LAKE PATROL PROGRAM THIS YEAR. THIS BOAT WILL BE PLACED IN THE HEBER AREA, (THE MIDDLE) PART OF THE COUNTY.

HAVING THESE BOATS STRATEGICALLY PLACED THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY WILL NOT ONLY PROVIDE BETTER PATROL AND SAFETY FOR BOATERS, BUT THE TIME SPENT RESPONDING TO A RESCUE, WILL BE MINIMAL. ALL THE BOATS ARE EQUIPPED WITH SONAR AND MEDICAL EQUIPMENT NEEDED TO RENDER FIRST AID.

THE LAKE PATROL PROGRAM CURRENTLY HAS FOUR CERTIFIED LAKE PATROL DEPUTIES. THESE DEPUTIES ARE ALSO CERTIFIED DIVERS AND HAVE OTHER JOB TASKS WITHIN THE DEPARTMENT, THEY WILL BE USED TO ASSIST THE FULL TIME LAKE PATROL OFFICER DURING THE HOLIDAYS AND SPECIAL EVENTS THAT MAY ARISE DURING THE PEAK AND OFF SEASON. OUR DEPARTMENT WILL BE SENDING TWO ADDITIONAL DEPUTIES THIS YEAR TO BOATING SCHOOL IN NOVEMBER TO ADD TO THE PROGRAM. THIS WILL ADD TO MORE MAN HOURS FOR MORE FREQUENT PATROL THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY.



* PROGRAM NARRATIVE CONTINUE:

THE PEAK SEASON AND OPERATION SCHEDULE OF THE BOATS, VARIES WITH THE TYPE OF RECREATIONAL USE. THE LAKES IN THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE COUNTY ARE USED FOR PLEASURE BOATERS AND FISHERMAN. IN THE NORTH PART OF THE COUNTY, WE ADD TO THE LIST WITH SPEED BOATERS AND JET SKIERS. OUR NORMAL PEAK SEASON, RUNS FROM APRIL THROUGH NOVEMBER, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF CHOLLA LAKE WHICH IS OPEN YEAR ROUND.

DURING THE PEAK BOATING SEASON, THE SHERIFF'S PATROL WILL CONTINUE, WITH THE HELP OF THE FULL TIME LAKE PATROL OFFICER, THE HIGH VISIBILITY THAT WE NOW HAVE ESTABLISHED. WITH THE ADDITIONAL PERSONNEL ASSISTING HIM. WE SHOULD BE, LIKE IN YEARS PAST, MAKE AN CONSIDERABLE IMPACT ON THE FINANCIAL LOSSES AND LOSS OF LIFE BY BOATERS.

THIS GRANT APPLICATION, IS BASED ON BOTH CURRANT NEEDS AND THOSE NEEDS PROJECTED OVER THE NEXT TWO YEARS. THE DEPARTMENT IS STRIVING TO MAINTAIN AND UPGRADE EQUIPMENT AND PERSONNEL TRAINING. LIKE ANY SPORT, ESPECIALLY THIS ONE, IT IS ON THE INCREASE DUE TO THE MAGNITUDE OF THE SPORT.

WITHOUT THE B.L.E.S.F. GRANTS THAT WE HAVE HAD IN THE PAST YEARS, WE WOULD NOT HAVE A LAKE PATROL PROGRAM. WE WOULD NOT HAVE THE EQUIPMENT OR THE TRAINING TO DO THE JOB. WITH THIS GRANT, WE CAN ENSURE THAT OUR LAKES AND RESCUE PROGRAM WILL CONTINUE TO MOVE FORWARD. THIS IS IMPORTANT TO US AND THE PEOPLE OF NAVAJO COUNTY. IT WILL ENSURE THAT WE WILL BE THERE FOR THEM.
