WHEREAS, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors did conduct noticed Public Hearings of proposed amendments to the Navajo County Zoning Ordinance on September 2, 1997.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Navajo County Board of Supervisors adopts the following:

1. Amendment of Navajo County Zoning Ordinance


The Zoning Ordinance is hereby amended by adding the following language to Article 22 - Recreational Vehicle Placement:

- Section 2207 - Temporary Construction Placement


Temporary placement of a single Recreational Vehicle may be approved by the Director of the Planning and Building Division at the same time a Navajo County Building Permit for a primary residence is issued. This Temporary placement is to run in conjunction with the Building Permit and for as long as the subject Building Permit is current and active. At such time as the Building Permit expires (or is revoked) or a Certificate of Occupancy is issued the applicant shall then meet all other provisions of Article 22 - Recreational Vehicle Placement and any other applicable ordinance requirement.
