### RESOLUTION NO. 121-97

### RESOLUTION OF THE NAVAJO COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

**WHEREAS**, The Arizona State Legislature under A.R.S. §5-383 has authorized the establishment of a Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund (BLESF) providing funds to the Board of Supervisors of Arizona counties for boating law enforcement and safety; and

**WHEREAS**, The Arizona State Parks Board is responsible for the administration of the fund program within the State, setting up necessary rules and procedures governing application by county Boards of Supervisors under the program; and

**WHEREAS**, said procedures established by State Parks require the applicant to certify by resolution the approval of applications, signature authorization, the availability of local matching funds, where appropriate; and

**WHEREAS**, the project will contribute to the boating law enforcement and safety programs the County;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Navajo County Board of Supervisors hereby:

1. Approves the filing of an application for Boating Law Enforcement and Safety Fund assistance; and
2. Certifies that Navajo County will comply with all appropriate state regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements as they relate to the application; and
3. Understands that the project scope and funding amount are subject to approval by the Arizona Outdoor Recreation Coordinating Commission and the State Parks Board; and

4. Authorized the Sheriff to act on behalf of Navajo County in conducting all negotiations, executing and submitting all documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and other documents which may be necessary for the completion of the BLESF project.
