Resolution No. 122-97

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF NAVAJO COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE SHERIFF TO CHARGE PAWN SHOPS A FEE TO OFFSET THE ACTUAL COST OF PRINTING AND PROVIDING DAILY REPORT FORMS REQUIRED BY A.R.S. § 44-1625**

**WHEREAS**, Section 44-1625(A) of the Arizona Revised Statutes requires pawnbrokers to "make a complete and accurate report each day of each article initially pledged or purchased by the pawnbroker on that day" and to deliver each report within two business days to the Sheriff (or his deisgnee) of the County in which the pawnbroker is licensed; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 44-1625(B) provides that the daily report shall be on a form provided or approved by the Sheriff; and

**WHEREAS**, the Navajo County Sheriff is obtaining price quotations for the printing of a daily report form meeting the statutory requirements; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 11-251.08 authorizes the Board of Supervisors to impose fees to offset the actual cost of products and services provided to the public; and

**WHEREAS**, A.R.S. § 44-1626(B)(6) authorizes pawnbrokers to pass through to their pawn customers any fee charged by the County "in connection with or as a result of the pawn transaction,"

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** as follows:

1. The Navajo County Sheriff is authorized to charge pawn shops licensed in this County a fee equal to the actual cost of purchasing and providing the daily report forms required pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-1625.


2. Reprints of the forms shall be obtained by the Sheriff as required at the most favorable price then available. The fee set forth in paragraph 1 shall increase or decrease automatically to reflect the actual cost of the forms as reprints are obtained.

3. Pawn shops may, but shall not be required to, pass through to their pawn customers pursuant to A.R.S. § 44-1626(B)(6) the fees charged by the Sheriff by authority of this resolution.
